**MOORPARK ARTIST ON SITE FOR FIRST ROUND AT NISSAN OPEN**  
**EMBELLISHING HIS 1998 WORK "LEGENDS OF GOLF";**  
**WORK TO BE DONATED TO LAJCC**

**WHO:** Local contemporary artist **Scott Medlock** of **Scott Medlock Fine Arts** was first introduced to the world of professional golf in 1991 when he was commissioned by Riviera CC to capture the image of tournament winner Ted Schulz. Medlock continued his work with the Nissan Open for several years before creating, in 1998, *Legends of Golf*, featuring Jack Nicklaus and Arnold Palmer on a fairway at Riviera with a silhouette of legendary Ben Hogan in the background.

**WHAT:** Medlock will be on-site at the 2002 Nissan Open embellishing *Legends of Golf* with highlights as he is inspired by first-round play at the 72-hole PGA TOUR tournament.

On Sunday, Medlock will donate his "new original" to the Los Angeles Junior Chamber of Commerce (LAJCC), organizer of the Nissan Open, in order to generate additional revenues for the benefiting charities.
